The expanded client offering comprises for example computers and servers, added software, data storage, network solutions, and ip telephony. Together with the existing Carl Lamm solutions for document management, combinations can be created that clients are increasingly asking for.

The acquisitions should be viewed as a step in preparing and creating the conditions for distribution of the shares in Carl Lamm to the stockholders in Scribona and a separate listing of the company. A decision in principal about this preparation work was made at Scribona's extraordinary general meeting in December of 2005.
